In the event of any legal or equitable action arising under this Agreement, the parties agree that the jurisdiction and venue of such action shall lie exclusively within the courts of record of the State of Florida located in Pinellas County, Florida.
- 4. Vendor(s) acknowledges College is subject to and must comply with Florida's Public Records Law, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. Vendor(s) also acknowledges its obligation to comply with the requirements of Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes. Vendor's failure to comply may result in immediate termination of this Agreement.
- 5. Vendor(s) shall maintain at its sole cost and expense general liability with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence. The insurance must be in effect throughout the dates of this Agreement. On all general liability polices, the Board of Trustees of St. Petersburg College shall be named as an additional insured and Vendor(s) shall no later than seven (7) days of the Event Date(s) provide the College with a Certificate of Insurance evidencing such coverage. Vendor(s) shall also maintain automobile coverage for any vehicles brought onto the College's property and workers compensation insurance as required by law, or if exempt, a declaration of exemption or exemption certificate. Failure to provide evidence of insurance coverage as set forth herein may result in immediate termination of this Agreement.
- 6. Vendor(s) shall indemnify, defend and hold the College harmless from and against any and all actions, liabilities, damages, expenses, claims, demands, and causes of action, including all expenses of litigation, including attorney's fees and court costs through appeal, arising out of or related to death or injury to any person, or the damage loss or destruction of any property which may occur as a result of any act or omission of Vendor(s).
- 7. Vendor(s) agrees to assume all costs arising from the use of patented, licensed, trademarked, franchised or copyrighted music, materials, devices, processes or dramatic rights.
